Horses may not have completed a BRC HT 90 or above in the same competition year. <b>Maximum height 1<sup>st</sup> Round 70cm, 2<sup>nd</sup> Rd 75cm, J/O 80cm</b></p>
<p>Class 2 SEIB <b>Junior 80cm Team and Individual Show Jumping Qualifier</b></p>	<p>Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club. Entries from teams or individuals. Horses may have 5 BE points, and 75 BS points. Horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have completed a BE Novice or above in the current or previous calendar year. <b>Maximum height 1<sup>st</sup> round 80cm, 2<sup>nd</sup> Rd 85cm, J/O 90cm</b></p>
<p>Class 3 SEIB <b>Mixed Open 80cm Show Jumping Qualifier</b></p>	<p>Open to Junior and Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club.  No restrictions on eligibility</p>
<p>Class 4 HorseHage &amp; Mollichaff <b>Junior 90cm Team and Individual Show Jumping Qualifier</b></p>	<p>Open to Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club. Entries from teams or individuals. Horses may have up to 500 BS points, 20 BE points. <b>Maximum height 1<sup>st</sup> round 90cm, 2<sup>nd</sup> Rd 95cm, J/O 100cm</b></p>
<p>Class 5 HorseHage &amp; Mollichaff <b>Senior &amp; Junior 100cm Show Jumping Team and Individual Qualifier</b></p>	<p>Open to Senior &amp; Junior members of an affiliated Riding Club. Entries from teams or individuals. Teams can be mixed Juniors &amp; Seniors, or all Seniors or all Juniors. Horses may have up to 999 BS points, 60 BE points. <b>Maximum height first round 100cm, 2<sup>nd</sup> Rd 105cm, J/O 110cm</b></p>

Entries from teams or individuals. Teams can be mixed Juniors &amp; Seniors, or all Seniors or all Juniors. Horses may have unlimited BS and BE points. <b>Maximum height first round 1.10m, 2<sup>nd</sup> Rd 1.15cm, J/O 1.20cm</b></p>

Horses may not have completed a BRC HT 90 or above in the same competition year. <b>Maximum height 1<sup>st</sup> Round 70cm, 2<sup>nd</sup> Rd 75cm, J/O 80cm</b></p>
<p>Class 8 SEIB <b>Senior 80cm Team and Individual Show Jumping Qualifier</b></p>	<p>Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club. Entries from teams or individuals. Horses may have 5 BE points, and 75 BS points. Horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have completed a BE Novice or above in the current or previous calendar year. <b>Maximum height 1<sup>st</sup> round 80cm, 2<sup>nd</sup> Rd 85cm, J/O 90cm</b></p>
<p>Class 9 HorseHage &amp; Mollichaff <b>Senior 90cm Team and Individual Show Jumping Qualifier</b></p>	<p>Open to Senior members of an affiliated Riding Club. Entries from teams or individuals. Horses may have up to 500 BS points, 20 BE points. <b>Maximum height 1<sup>st</sup> round 90cm, 2<sup>nd</sup> Rd 95cm, J/O 100cm</b></p>

**DO NOT FORGET TO MAKE YOUR PRELIMINARY ENTRIES TO BRITISH RIDING CLUBS:**

**This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Rule Book and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: [3216 BRChandbook 2022 \(2\).pdf](#)**

All entrants must pay a prelim entry of **£36** per team or **£11** per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries [www.britishridingclubs.org.uk](http://www.britishridingclubs.org.uk) or online entries can be made via the BRC website [British Riding Clubs - Login \(bhs.org.uk\)](http://British Riding Clubs - Login (bhs.org.uk)). Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late



surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All hats must have a visible **aqua** BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. If your hat does not currently have a tag, please send a photo of the hat's safety standards to Tony Parker to check. For up to date hat rules please see the current rule book.

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS.**

1. Rules for Official Competitions 2022.
2. Protective head gear as specified in the BHS Riding Club "Rules for Official Competitions" 2022 must be worn by everyone mounted, whether competing or not. Failure to do so will incur elimination. The wearing of a back/body protector as specified in the BHS Riding Club "Rules for Official Competitions" 2022 is recommended for show jumping.
3. All Horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over.
4. Objections to be made in writing to the Organisers, accompanied by a deposit of £10, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
5. Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times.



6. Solihull Riding Club, its officers or anyone acting on their behalf shall not be held responsible for any accident, injury, loss or damage to or by horses, ponies, competitors, spectators or any persons, animals or property whatsoever.
7. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever.
8. No entrant shall be entitled to the return of any entry fee after closing date other than on production of the appropriate Veterinary or Medical Certificate and at the organisers' discretion.
